H. I have to acquaint you that in September last the Society's Surveyors at Rotterdam reported that the barque "PASSAT" had been examined in drydock fully loaded on account of damage to the bow plating through collision. Partial and temporary repairs were effected, and the Surveyors recommended permanent repairs to be carried out on the vessel's return from her contemplated voyage.

The vessel recently arrived at Delfzijl and the Ommees' Representative has informed the Society's Surveyors at Amsterdam that the requisite drydocking and repairs will take place at Hamburg, whither the vessel is to proceed this week, and I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention.
