Nature of Survey _____

This vessel has been placed in dry dock fully loaded on account of damage to bow plating through collision, and the following repairs carried out:- 4 shell plates renewed, 8 shell plates, 11 frames, 11 reverse frames and 1 beam repaired, starboard hawsepipes renewed and minor repairs effected.

Some temporary repairs have also been carried out and the Surveyors recommend that permanent repairs be effected on the vessel's return from her present voyage.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as recommended.
