Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your Report C.11 in the case of the steamer "PASSAT", and with regard thereto may say that in order to comply with the Convention requirements the following will require to be done:-

1. Efficient means of closing should be provided for all ventilators, if this is not already the case.
2. Fittings for lashings should be provided for No.1 hatchway.

The report in question is returned herewith for completion of the sheers on page 1. and I may say that on receipt of particulars of the same the case will be completed and the freeboards assigned.

I have to add that the freeing port area is less than that required by the Convention, but in the event of the existing freeboards being re-assigned, the present area could be accepted.
