"PASSAT", and I shall be glad if you will give the case attention when the vessel drydocks at your port.

For your guidance I enclose herewith a print of the midship section, and I have to say that your recommendations in respect to the renewal or doubling of any individual plates found to be unduly wasted may (provided the surfaces of the plating are in good condition) take account of the thickness of shell plating required by the present Rules, and also of any special features of the internal construction, such as intercostal side stringers.

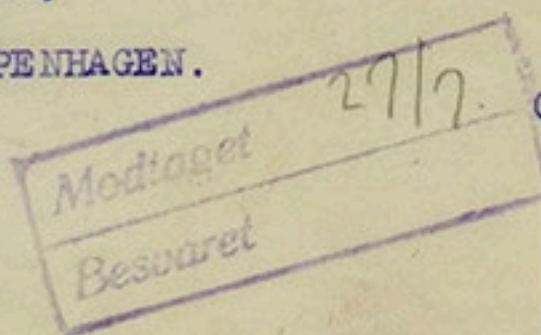
Drilling sheets are also sent herewith and I shall be glad if you will return the print to this Office with your report.
