With reference to my letter of yesterday relative to the Steel Bk. "PASSAT", I have to send herewith a list of the original scantlings of this vessel on which particulars of the present Rule requirements have been indicated, and I have to say that your recommendations in respect to the renewal or doubling of any individual plates found to be unduly wasted may (provided the surfaces of the plating are in good condition) take account of the thickness of shell plating required by the present Rules, and also of any special feature of the internal construction, such as intercostal side stringers.

Drilling sheets are also enclosed.
