With reference to the 2nd Special Survey No.3 which became due at the end of March last on the Steel Bk. "PASSAT", I have to acquaint you that I am informed by the Owner that this vessel is now on her way to Mariehamn where the requirements of the Special Survey afloat will be carried out, and that the bottom survey will be held later at Copenhagen where she is to be drydocked. In the circumstances the Committee will authorize you to carry out the part of the 2nd Special Survey No.3 in this instance, but I am directed to inform you that in view of the importance of the inspection your survey should be of a stringent character and great care should be exercised.

I may add that particulars of the vessel's scantlings are being prepared, and will be forwarded to you in due course.
