REDUCED RATE TELEGRAMS

of the following indicators, which counts as one word, must be inserted before the address and included in the number of words to be paid for.

= LT = **LETTER TELEGRAM.**—Service to countries outside Europe. Half ordinary rate. Plain language only and minimum charge is for 22 words.

= ELT = **EUROPEAN LETTER TELEGRAM.**—Service to Europe only. Half ordinary rate. Plain language only and minimum charge is for 22 words.

= GLT = **COMMONWEALTH SOCIAL TELEGRAM.**—Service to places in the Commonwealth including territories under Mandate or Trusteeship. For greetings, family news or non-commercial personal affairs. Plain language only. Minimum charge is 5s. 0d. for 11 words, except to Canada and the British West Indies, to which lower rates apply.

CONDITIONS

1.—Either the Postmaster General or any Telegraph Company or Government, by whom this telegram is or would in the ordinary course of the telegraphic service be forwarded, may decline to forward the telegram although it has been received for that purpose; but in such case the amount paid for transmission shall be refunded to the sender at his request.

2.—Neither the Postmaster General nor any officer of the Post Office nor any Telegraph Company or Government, by which this telegram is or would in the ordinary course of the telegraphic service be forwarded, nor any of the servants or officers of such Telegraph Company or Government, shall be liable to make compensation for any loss, injury, or damage arising or resulting from non-transmission or non-delivery of the telegram, or delay, or error, or omission in the transmission or delivery thereof, through whatever cause such non-transmission, non-delivery, delay, error, or omission shall have occurred.

3.—This telegram shall be forwarded in all respects in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations with reference to Overseas Telegrams made pursuant to the Telegraph Acts, and the provisions of such Regulations shall be deemed to be binding not only between the sender and the Postmaster General, but between the sender and any Telegraph Company or Government by whom this telegram is or would in the ordinary course of the telegraphic service be forwarded.

I declare that the text of this telegram complies with the special language or other regulations applicable to its category or rate of charge. I request that this telegram may be forwarded on the faith of the foregoing declaration and subject to the above conditions, to which I agree.
