We have to inform you that we are in receipt of a letter from the Owners' Agents stating that the above vessel, which has been laid up at Travemünde for several years is to be placed in drydock on the 5th September for bottom painting and minor repairs. They have been instructed by the Owners (Landesbank und Girozentrale Schleswig-Holstein) to apply to us for "survey of the ship and machinery and renewal of the class which will expire at the end of January, 1956".
