With reference to your letter of the 18th  
 no, regarding outstanding accounts, and to previous  
 correspondence in connexion with the liquidation of  
 Messrs. Reederei Schliewen, previous owners of the  
 "PAMIR" and "PASSAT", we have to inform you that in  
 reply to further enquiries the liquidator, Mr. Frie-  
 drich C.T. Busch, states that although the Society's  
 claims (on a 35% basis) have been accepted, it is  
 improbable that there will be any assets left,  
 even if the priority claims have been met, to pay even  
 a proportion of the amount due to us.

In the meantime the "PAMIR" has recently been  
 surveyed at this port for Docking and Screwshaft  
 work, and the fees will be charged to the present  
 owners' local Agents, namely, Messrs. Zersson & Co.  
 It seems extremely unlikely, however, that the Landes-  
 Girozentrale Schleswig-Holstein, the present  
 owners, will accept any responsibility for the debts  
 previously incurred on this ship.
