Dear Sir,

Sailing Ship "PASSAT"

We refer to your letter of the 10th September and recent correspondence in connection with this ship. We should like to advise you now that due to the disaster on her sister ship the future of this vessel is somewhat uncertain, and to-date the Owners have no definite plans for her future use.

We have intimated to the Owners the classification survey requirements for the postponement of Special Survey desired, and have to advise you that while the Owners are quite prepared to carry out a General Examination afloat, they would appreciate if you could agree to this postponement without an examination in drydock, as they cannot guarantee this examination during the laying-up period. At the same time, for your information, this ship being dual class, the Germanischer Lloyd have already granted a year's postponement of Special Survey without any examination, subject to a drydocking survey prior to the ship being put back into service.

The undersigned accompanied the Surveyor concerned on the occasion of the last drydocking, and the ship was found to be in good condition at that time and it is submitted for the consideration of the Committee that the Owners' request for a General Examination only afloat be granted on the understanding that the ship is drydocked prior to resuming service.
