REPAIRS

Now done, the inside and outside surfaces of the plating scraped and painted, the whole of the ceiling in the hold lifted and the cement repaired where necessary;
 Chains ranged, examined and found good and sufficient - Repaired an Anchor Stock. The main Mast bent of Peak, the upper Main Topmast yard bent of Red pine. - Repaired one complete suit of Sails, - and supplied several new Sails; - also a Kedge Anchor $2\frac{1}{4}$ cwt; one 9/2 inch, one 7/2 inch and one 5/2 inch Hawsers. -
