Nature of Survey

S.S. No. 1 + Damage

On account of damage by fire :- upper and lower
docks partly renewed : wood bulkhead at after end of forecastle renewed
with iron : forecastle deck renewed : 12 forecastle beams and 4
stringer plates and pillars to forecastle beams faired and re-fitted,
and foremast renewed : The requirements of the S.S. No. 1, due 12.93, have
now been complied with.

The Surveyor states that the record of deck erections
in the Register Book should be amended to "P 92' and F 103'".

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain
classed *A1* with record of survey 2.94, and notation of S.S. Lth. No. 1
-94, as recommended.
