Nature of Survey _____

The Leith Surveyors report this vessel has been placed in dry dock, the bottom and rudder cleaned and coated and the 5th. S.S.No.1, due 6.19, carried out.

On account of wear and tear, the rudder has been lifted and pintles rebushed as required, frames and reverse frames repaired as required, deck and tunnel plating renewed as necessary, and sundry minor repairs carried out.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 6.20 and notation of S.S.Lth.No.1-20.
