In October last the Owners stated the vessel was on the point of sailing for the Mediterranean, and they suggested she might be allowed to run until January before having the above surveys held. In the circumstances, the Committee deferred consideration of the case for a time.

At the end of January, it appeared that the steamer had left London for Lisbon and Genoa without being submitted to survey, and in reply to enquiry the Owners stated the overdue surveys would receive attention on her return to the U.K. from the latter port. Action was therefore deferred until the vessel's return from the voyage in question.

In reply to enquiry the Leith Surveyors now state the vessel was stopped for the overdue surveys, but in view of the iron workers strike she has been sent for a trip to the Baltic in the meantime, and is expected to be back in a month's time.
