Vessel placed in Dry Dock bottom cleaned examined & coated & found in order. Rudder listed, examined & found with somewhat deflected from being true. Port & starboard carefully examined & found sound, and rudder is in my opinion efficient for its work. New top judgement riveted to stern frame, & new locking plate fitted. Bulkhead examined & appeared in order.
