Dear Sirs,

We refer to your letter of yesterday's date regarding Surveys due on the steamers "Corsica", "Inverawe", and "Stettin", presently laid up at Leith. We observe that your Committee are agreeable to all these Surveys being postponed for the present, and we on our part undertake that the Boiler Survey and Special No. 3 Survey of the "Corsica", and the Boiler and Screw Shaft Surveys of the "Inverawe" will be carried out before these vessels are again placed in commission. The case of the "Stettin" is a little different as her No. 2 Survey only became due in November last, and it might suit our arrangements to do only part of the work required in this connection, leaving the balance to be completed before her year of service arrives.
