With reference to my letter of the 26th June last addressed to the Owners, a copy of which was forwarded to you, I shall be glad to learn, as this vessel appears to have left Leith on the 30th ultimo, how the case now stands as regards the Boiler Survey.

Date:— 6th October, 1931.

Owing to receiving a very urgent request from their Hamburg office for a vessel to lift 600 tons of cargo at that port, the Owners rushed this vessel out on little more than 24 hours notice. This did not give them time to hold the boiler survey, but arrangements have now been made to dry dock the vessel and carry out the boiler survey, on her return to this port early next week.
