I have surveyed the Machinery in order to Survey & to ascertain the repairs made at Batoum & here.

Damage Repairs as reported New Spare-Brank-Shaft fitted, bottom-end-brasses & eccentrics fitted to same. New Thrust-Shaft, thrust block & brasses & new plummer block fitted. Cylinders pistons & air & circulating pumps, feed & bilge pumps, overhauled, new shaft coupling, bolts & keys fitted to the fly wheel.

The slide valve spindle welded turned & new bushes fitted, new nuts pins ect. Feed & bilge pumps rods & lined & bushed, turned & gland rebushed, Cylinder drain cocks new ones fitted & pipe repaired. Iron cover fitted to high pressure cylinder with felt lagging. New hinges for bilge interceptor

Injections Sea cock & valves & Stern stuffing box overhauled.

Main Boiler. Blow down pipe repaired, new drain cock fitted, Water gauges & test cocks, drain cocks & pipes repaired.

Donkey Boiler - New door for mud hole hinges on Donkey casing fitted.
