Sir,

As requested in your letter of the 6th inst., I
beg to forward herewith two plans received from
the Wallsend Shipway, showing the arrangements now
made in connection with the oil fuel system fitted in
the Steamer "Mineral", and where the pipes are
disconnected.

With regard to the proposal to carry oil fuel
in No 2 oil tank, this idea has now been abandoned
and the wood bulkheads removed; the fuel suction
pipe, has however been allowed to remain and is
disconnected at the cofferdam bulkheads by means of
blank flanges.
