

"Composite Ship Leander" 848 Tons.
(No. 2824 in the Register Book) built in
1867, and classed 16 A 1 "C.F."

This vessel has now been Specially
Surveyed in accordance with the Rules for
Composite Ships Section 43: and is recommended
for an improved class under Amended Table I.

On reference to the First Entry Report
and from examination of the vessel, it is found
that the timber materials used in her construction
are all of the 16 years grade by Amended Table I.
She is now in good condition.

Under these circumstances it is submitted
this vessel appears worthy of the favorable
consideration of the Committee to be raised to
the 18 A 1 class as recommended; - namely
