Composite Ship "Leander" 886 Tons -  
No. 260 in the Register Book - built  
in 1867 and Classed 18 A.I.

This vessel has now been specially  
surveyed for the completion of the  
Continuation Survey, Section 45, and  
the iron bolts in the topsides have  
been renewed with yellow metal to  
the height of the upper deck stringer  
plate, and the vessel is recommended  
to be raised to the 19 A.I. Class and  
Continued A.I. for 13 yrs from 1886.  
Subject to the sails being made  
good as arranged before the vessel  
proceeds on her voyage. See Owners  
guarantee attached.

It is submitted that this  
vessel appears worthy of the  
favorable consideration of the  
Committee to be raised to  
the 19 A.I. Class viz 16 yrs Table I
