

In reference to the attached letter received from Messrs Ross & Co. the owners of the composite ship "Leander" the following remarks are submitted for the consideration of the Committee.

This Composite Ship was subjected to a portion of the <sup>requirements of the</sup> Special Survey at Glasgow in Nov 1890, when she was found in an unsatisfactory condition in many parts. A portion of the repairs found necessary were done at that time, and the Committee allowed the vessel to retain her class until her return from the intended voyage. She has now returned and is at Liverpool, and as she is not chartered there does not appear to be any reason why the requirements of the Special Survey should not be complied with at the present time.
