S.S. (Composite) pt

The requirements of the Rules for Special Survey of Composite vessels have been complied with. all close ceiling removed.

Cement renewed on fore & after ends of vessel, and in 10 other frame spaces where removed for survey. 74 wasted reverse frames now doubled. A number of rivets renewed. 60 broken metal bolts renewed. worn ends of pumps cut off & leaden ends fitted. Rudder renewed. All metal sheathing entirely stripped.

Bottom re-caulked and re-sheathed with 4 in on felt.

The main deck has been bored and found to be less than 3 in thickness and therefore requires to be renewed. It is however reported to be in good condition.

It is submitted the Owner should be informed that on account of the deck being worn down below the limit of thickness admitted by the Rules it is necessary for the same to be renewed to render the vessel eligible to retain her class and they should be requested to state when and where they propose to have this done.

When the deck has been renewed the vessel will be eligible to have record of survey 10.92 and notation S.S. HKG. 92 also record of 774/M 10.92
