

The Clipper "Cutty Sark".

On the 5th May last year you informed me that your Chairman, Sir Ronald Garrett had kindly authorised Mr. J.M. Robertson to serve on the committee which had been set up by the Council to investigate the possibility of preserving the "Cutty Sark".
