

Composite Barque "Cutty Sark" 921 Tons.
(N. 1518 in the Register Book) built at
Dumbarton in 1869-11 mo. and classed 16A1. "C.F."

This vessel has now been submitted to
Special Survey, and is recommended to be
raised, under Amended Rules for metal fastenings, and
Amended Table I, to the 19A1 class. "C.F."

The whole of the timber materials in the
construction of this vessel are raised by the
Amended Table I, to the 16 years grade; and
the whole of the external fastenings from the lower
part of the keel to the height of the main deck are of
yellow metal

Under these circumstances, and in view of the
favorable report on her condition, it is submitted
this vessel appears to merit the favorable consideration
of the Committee to be raised, as recommended to the
19A1 class, namely.

16 years under Amended Table I,

and 3 years for metal fastenings, instead of 2 years as
at present assigned.
