Sir,

In reply to the post. note of your letter of the 12th inst. respecting the S.S. Geographique, late Vaderland, I beg to inform you that I have not been called to hold the required survey on the Boilers. - On receipt of your Note, I went on Board where I was informed that the Boilers have been tested, this day, by cold water up to 95 lbs per sq" in presence of Surveyors appointed by the French Consul and found efficient.

I have told the Master that the Boilers ought to be surveyed by me in accordance with the Rules to which he replied considering that he had no instructions from his owners and the Ship being ready to sail for Havre to-morrow morning the survey must be complied with in Havre or on a later date.
