Portion of Survey held, &c.

The 2nd S.S.No.3 due 10.96 was completed at Antwerp in July last, with exception of the renewal of the two topmasts and repairing of the tank top under boilers. The two topmasts were subsequently renewed.

The Antwerp Surveyor now states in reply to enquiry that the Owners intend to renew the tank top under boilers by degrees, they propose on the vessel's next arrival in January next to place her in dry dock, and to lift the boilers on one side and repair the tank top in way thereof, and on her return in June next to again place her in dry dock and lift the boilers on the other side and so complete the repairs.

The year of grace expired at the end of last month.

It is submitted, under the circumstances, that the Owners' proposal merits the favourable consideration of the Committee, and in the meantime the vessel might be allowed to remain classed, record of survey and notation of 2nd S.S.No.3 being deferred until completion of the repairs.
