Sir,
In reply to your Classification-letter of the 20th inst.
respecting the 2nd Special Survey N°3 of the S.S. 'Nederland'
I beg to inform you:
That the repair of the Red-piece of stem-frame is to be con-
sidered as permanent.

That the defective topmasts will be replaced by new on the
vessel's return from present voyage, but as regards repairs,
or renewal of tank-top under boilers, the Superintendent
could give me no reply, saying that this case must come
before the Directors of the Society, and that they will decide
whether they want the tank-top to be renewed (as has been
done in 'Switzerland') or whether they want it taken off,
i.e. to do away with the tank.
