Nature of Survey

Part S.S. No. 1.

The S.S. No. 1 due 7.01 was partly held at Antwerp in February & September last & to complete the same, all ballast tanks require to be tested, the masts, spars, rigging & mast ^{& pump} rigging to be examined & No 2 hold & bottom of side bunkers to be examined.

The Antwerp Surveyors now report that the ceiling has been lifted in the fore part of starboard side bunker. The tank top was found to be thin & the riveting started. The riveting has been renewed & it has been arranged to renew the plating & complete the S.S. No. 1 when the vessel is laid up at the beginning of the year.

It is submitted this proposal merits approval & the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed record of survey & notation of S.S. No. 1. being deferred for completion of same.
