Survey due Boiler Survey due July, 1903.

In September last year the Surveyors at Antwerp wrote that this vessel was lying up at Philadelphia and she has remained at that port since then. In March last the Owners gave the usual guarantee that requested in the cases of vessels lying up indefinitely.

The Surveyors at Antwerp now write that they have been informed the Owners that the vessel is still at Philadelphia and it has been arranged that in the event of the vessel again sailing, she will proceed direct to Antwerp where the inspection in question will be held.

It is submitted that in view of the boiler survey being more than 13 months overdue it should be held before the vessel proceeds to sea. The boilers appear to be more than 31 years old.
