With reference to the freeboard of the S.S. "AQUITANIA", you will be pleased to know that this question has now been settled with the Board of Trade, and we are issuing assignment letters to-night giving a freeboard for all seasons corresponding to an extreme draught of 36'-2". This is an increase of 10" in Summer and 19" in winter, and I have no doubt will be satisfactory.

The case of the "BERENGARIA" is in hand, and we will let you know the result at a later date.
