structures for the D.C. motors of the scavenging turbo-blowers on the
Pacific Liners No. 450 and 451 of the Nippon Yusen Kaisha built by
Mitsubishi Dockyards, Nagasaki, BCC order No. 42456.**

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the
Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees
of the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other
expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connexion therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations
of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:-
