The Receivers have been built in accordance with the approved plans and to the Society's Rules and requirements, the materials and workmanship are good.

The Receivers were, in the presence of the undersigned, tested by hydraulic pressure to 575 lbs. per square inch, showed no signs of weakness, and were found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure.

Working pressure not to exceed three hundred and fifty lbs. per square inch.
