Stl. Twin So. "VICEROY OF INDIA".

A letter has been received from the Glasgow Office in which it is stated that Mr. Potts has reexamined the plans of this vessel and finds that the scantlings and arrangements are equivalent to the Rule requirements for a Summer moulded draught of 28'7".

It is therefore now permissible for a freeboard corresponding to an all Seasons moulded draught of 28'0" to be approved.

It is submitted the freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those which correspond to the approved moulded draught of 28'0" for all Seasons, merit approval, the same to be marked on the vessel's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification and recorded in the Register Book.

The Glasgow Office should be advised and when the marking is amended by the Board of Trade, they should forward an amended verification of marking form in order that the necessary records may be made.

It is further submitted the Board of Trade be advised, and a copy of the amended computation be sent for their information.
