Dear Mr. Potts,

Many thanks for your letter of yesterday's date with reference to the case of the "NORTHERN PRINCE", and the method of dealing with the scantlings for vessels of limited draught.

I note that your practice is the same as that followed in this Office, and that in future cases you will see that "Summer" or "All Seasons" draughts are indicated on the scantling sheets.

We have assigned freeboards with the usual Seasonal allowances for this vessel.

An official letter on the same subject, but dealing with the case of Stephen's No. 519, is being sent to Glasgow tonight. We would like an early reply to this enquiry as the Board of Trade are hanging up the assignment pending advice from us.
