With reference to Glasgow report No. 48836 on the freeboards of the steamer "VICEROY OF INDIA", Messrs. A. Stephens' Yard No. 519, I now send herewith a copy of a letter which has been received from the Board of Trade giving the freeboards which have been assigned to this vessel. The Surveyors should now arrange to verify the markings and forward the usual verification of marking form with a view to the freeboards being entered on the certificates of classification and recorded in the Register Book.

I may add that the statutory deck line is to be $\frac{1}{2}$ " above the top of the composition and lining on the upper deck amidships.
