Dear Sir,

I have to acquaint you that a telephonic communication has been received from the Board of Trade to the effect that they have received an application for assignment of freeboard to Messrs. Alexander Stephen & Sons' Yard No. 519.

As freeboard is a condition of the class of this vessel, it will be necessary for the freeboards to receive the approval of the Committee, and I shall be glad if the Surveyors will forward their report as early as possible, as the Board of Trade are deferring assignment pending the receipt of the freeboards which could be approved by the Committee.

At the same time I have to add that it should be made clear if the scantlings are suitable for an all Seasons draught or if the usual Seasonal allowances should be made, in view of the restricted draught of 28 feet moulded being a condition of class.
