

REPORT on the

J. L. L. Stephensons No 519.

It is submitted the Glasgow office be informed that a telephonic communication has been received from the Board of Trade that they have received an application for assignment of freeboard for this vessel.

As freeboard is a condition of class it will be necessary for the freeboards to receive the approval of the committee. For this purpose the Surveyor's report should be forwarded as early as possible, as the Board of Trade are deferring assignment pending receipt of the freeboards which could be approved by the committee.

In view of the restricted draught of 28ft. mandated as a condition of class, it should be made clear if the scantlings are suitable for an all seasons draught or if the usual seasonal allowances should be made.
