Dear Sirs,

F. I have to inform you that the tanker "AGNITA" which is due at your port about the 22nd instant, is to be transferred to the British Flag. If the vessel will be permitted to sail on her Netherlands Load Line Certificate no action need be taken by you as on reaching the United Kingdom, the Special Survey and Renewal Load Line Survey will be held and a British Certificate issued. If, however, she is not permitted to sail on the Netherlands Certificate, you should verify the markings, amend the lettering in accordance with the British Law and issue a provisional Certificate on Rpt.10 valid for six months. A copy of the Certificate, together with the usual marking form, should be sent to this Office.

A memorandum of the freeboards is enclosed for your guidance.
