With reference to Mr. Leicester's letter of the 29th ultimo, addressed to Dr. Dorey, a Principal Surveyor on the Chief Engineer Surveyor's Staff, regarding the case of the s.s. "REX", I have to acquaint you that the matter was submitted to the Sub-Committee for Classification at their Meeting today, when they came to the conclusion that, in the circumstances, they can only issue a certificate of classification, subject to the same qualification as that contained in the Interim Certificate already issued by you.
