The freeboard of this ship is a condition of class, and the freeboards which have been assigned by the Registro Italiano correspond to the all seasons/<sup>moulded</sup> draught of 30.35 ft. for which the scantlings were approved by this Society.

It is therefore submitted the freeboards given on the accompanying form, being those assigned by the Registro Italiano, merit approval, the same to be marked on the ship's sides, inserted in the certificate of classification, and recorded in the Register Book.

It is noted that the freeboards have been assigned by the Registro Italiano (as was also the case in the m.s. " NEPTUNIA ") from the bulkhead deck instead of from the uppermost continuous deck, ~~which would be regarded as the freeboard deck by this Society~~, but when submitting their verification of marking form the Surveyors should report the freeboards as actually marked on the ship's sides, together with the extreme draught as given on the Builder's displacement scale, for record in the Register Book.
