With reference to Mr. Stupari's letter of the 22nd instant addressed to Dr. S.F. Dorey, respecting the boilers of the s.s. "CONTE DI SAVOIA", I have to acquaint you that as the scantlings of the water tube boilers in question are suitable for a working pressure of 32.5 kgs. per sq.cm., the proposal to adjust the safety valves to 30 kgs. per sq.cm., is in order.

I may add that the working pressure to be recorded in the Register Book will be 30 kgs. per sqcm.
