With reference to your reports Nos.2619 and 2621 on the new Steamer "AWATEA", I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th and telegram of today, from which it is observed that the fees in this case have now been paid, and that the result of the trial has proved satisfactory.

As arranged, therefore, the classification certificates are enclosed herewith for issue to the Builders.

In reply to your enquiry regarding the allocation of the electrical fee of £84.12.0, I have to say that in this case one-fifth (£16.18.0) will be allocated to London account for the survey of the electric generators at Rugby, in accordance with Circular No.1687, and the remainder will be equally divided between the Liverpool and Barrow offices, namely:- £33.17.0 to each port.
