Dear Sir,

Reverting to my letter dated the 10th August last in respect of a cast seel sternframe manufactured by Messrs. A.G. Henrichs hütte, Hattingen, and intended for Messrs. Eriksbergs Mek. Verks. A.B. Yard No.292, I beg to acquaint you that in view of the prevailing conditions it has been impossible to obtain a new sternframe in time. In these circumstances the Owners have agreed that the defects on the existing sternframe may be made good by electric welding to the satisfaction of the Society's Surveyors. The casting has therefore been dealt with at the Makers works and re-inspected by the Society's Surveyors and the certificate suitably endorsed.

The casting has also been inspected here by the undersigned and its condition is now regarded as satisfactory.

A translated copy of a letter from the Builders regarding this sternframe is enclosed herewith.
