1. The Charter-party signed with the Ministry of Transport on the 27th August 1946 for L.S.T. 3512, provides for the following employment under para 5 :-

"The ship shall throughout the Charterparty be at the absolute disposal and under the complete control of the Charterers, except that the Charterers shall employ the ship in Baltic, Mediterranean or Home Waters only."

2. It is our desire that the vessel, in addition to trading in Home Trade waters, may be employed between this country and Denmark, also with (and within) the Mediterranean.

3. L.S.T.3512 is now under Survey at Tilbury and it will be appreciated if the recommendation of your Surveyor may be in accord with the proposed employment of the ship.

4. We might add that there is at the present time a lack of freight space available for the export from this country of Motor Transport beyond Home Trade limits, and the employment of L.S.T. for this purpose should release room for the carriage of general cargoes overseas.
