Steamers "EMPIRE GANLIC" and "EMPIRE CEDRIC"

I enclose a copy of a letter dated the 4th instant which has been received from Messrs. Matthews, Wrightson, Burbidge, Ltd., together with a copy of the enclosure referred to therein, which are self-explanatory.

Please make arrangements for the ships to be generally examined and found or placed in a satisfactory condition for the proposed voyage in tow.

An Interim Certificate may be issued in each case as desired as an unclassified ship, and the Certificates should indicate that the towage arrangements are the responsibility of the Owners, and relate only to the fitness of the hull of each ship to be towed.

So far as the load line is concerned, it is concluded that Load Line Certificates will not be required for the voyage, otherwise Freeboard Surveys should be carried out.
