lubricating oil pipe to No.7 (from forward) bearing whilst on a voyage
from Punta Cardon, Venezuela to Curacao. N.W.I. on 15th May 1948.

FOUND

No.6 piston (from forward) had
been seized in the liner and now
found to be fractured circum-
ferentially above the gudgeon pin.

No.6 liner scored.

Lubricating oil pipe to No.7
bearing broken off in way of
coupling nut.

Connecting rod and gudgeon pin.

White metal of No.7 main bearing
slightly overheated and wiped.

No.6 crank pin brasses slightly
overheated and wiped.
