Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that your Reports of Survey, numbered below, have been submitted to the Committee, and your recommendations confirmed except as stated.

1190. As recommended.

Drilling Pontoons "SQ 9" and "SQ 10". (N.V.Werf Gusto Yard Nos. 101 and 102). First Entry Reports have been received from the Rotterdam Surveyors in respect of these vessels which have been built for the Shell Company of Qatar Ltd. No equipment was supplied when the vessels were built, and it is therefore assumed it was the Owners' intention to supply the equipment when the pontoons arrived at their destination at Qatar. Assignment of the class @100A1 Pontoon has accordingly been deferred in the meantime and I shall be glad if you will obtain full particulars, including weights, tests etc. of the equipment which, it is concluded, has since been supplied in each case, forwarding the same to this Office on form Rpt. 8, together with a statement from the Owners to the effect that from their experience this equipment is suitable for the intended service.
