I acknowledge your letter of the 8th April, and with regard thereto shall be glad if you will again communicate with the Owners and advise them that, in addition to the long overdue Donkey Boiler Survey, the Continuous Survey cycle of the machinery is considerably overdue, and that the present position is as follows:-

Items not seen for more than four years:-

Starboard main engine No.3,4,5 & 6 crankpins and bearings.

Items not seen for more than five years:-

Port main engine No.8 cylinder, piston, rod, valves and gears, connecting rod, top end and guides.

Port main engine No.3,4,5 & 6 crankpins and bearings.

Port main engine No.5 journal and main bearing.

Starboard main engine scavenge blower.

Port and starboard intermediate shafting and bearings.

Items not seen for more than six years:-

Starboard main engine Nos.3,4,5, & 6 journals and main bearings.
