Dear Sir,

I refer to your letter of the 26th May regarding the classification of Indonesian Coastal Vessels.

We note that Mr. Soei has confirmed that L.R./B.V. Surveys for all PELNI vessels have been suspended with effect from March last, but in view of the Owners' letter of the 6th April addressed to this Office, we conclude that they will notify us when they desire the remaining 25 ships to be taken out of class.

It is appreciated that no official request for withdrawal of class may be received from the Owners of other coastwise tonnage, and in that event each case will be submitted to the Committee when we are unable to obtain any information about overdue survey requirements.
